This program is open to all **high school and home-schooled juniors** in the Prince George Electric Cooperative (PGEC) service areas whose parent or guardian is a member of PGEC. Participants must complete an application form, write a brief essay, and submit his/her 30 second video to be considered for the contest.

Students who are selected for the four available all expenses paid Washington Electric Youth Tour spots sponsored by PGEC will join 1,500 high school students from the U.S. to learn about electric cooperatives, American history, and the United States government. Students will also visit the historic sites of the nation’s capital and get a chance to meet with their congressional leaders. Representing PGEC on this trip is an excellent way to bolster college applications.
